Migrated projects from svn to git, implemented jenkins builds, developed processes for backlog review, increased adoption of agile concepts and improved our support process. Increased the number of software releases YOY. In 2017 we had 19 releases, 34 releases in 2018 (79% increase year over year) and are on track for a strong 2019.

- Document Quality Review - Performed performance testing for the solution and worked with early adopting clients to install in their production environments. This included working with our technology partner (Nuance) to coordinate the remaining features, performance testing and client go lives.
- PatientSecure - Developed a solution which used patient palm scans (Imprivata) to search for users within the EMR. This included integrating the vendors API into our patient search workflow, vendor management and early adopting client deployments.
- HotSpot Dictation - Developed a SOAP service which dictation service providers used to pull digital transcriptions and push transcribed notes back into the clinical record. Developed the API and worked with transcriptions companies to consume it.

- Patient ESignature - Developed an electronic signature application where patients reviewed and signed required forms electronically (Lexmark) at the point of hospital registration. Coordinated production go live events with early adopting clients. This set the stage for the solution to be sold and delivered to additional clients.
